Crimestoppers

If you have information about a crime that you want to give anonymously you can call Crimestoppers on **freephone 0800 555 111**.

No caller is asked for their name and if the information you give results in the arrest and charging of a suspect, you may be entitled to a cash reward from the Crimestoppers Trust. This can also be paid anonymously.

Crimestoppers is an independent charity which helps the police to solve crime and catch criminals. Since it began, Crimestoppers has received 392,000 calls leading to over 36,600 arrests and the recovery of property valued at £49 million. Each arrest costs Crimestoppers Trust, the parent charity, £200 and there is an average of 14 arrests every day. On average, each week there are 44 arrests for drug offences and one for murder or attempted murder.
