



Digital Cameras and Associated Equipment Policy

1.0 Policy Statement

- 1.1 The British Transport Police (BTP) will utilise digital photographic and other associated equipment for operational purposes, ensuring that any evidence obtained is clearly auditable and admissible in a court of law.

2.0 Overview

- 2.1 This policy incorporates the recommendations from the joint Home Office and Association of Chief Police Officers Digital Imaging Procedure, 2002, document produced by the Police Scientific Development Branch, and the Association of Chief Police Officers of Scotland Scottish Digital Imaging Strategy, 2004.
- 2.2 This policy will apply to all BTP staff.
- 2.3 This policy applies to England, Scotland and Wales.

3.0 Applicable Date, Monitoring and Review

- 3.1 This policy is applicable from 15 June 2006.
- 3.2 This policy will be reviewed every three years.

4.0 Ownership

- 4.1 This policy is owned by ACC (Crime).
