



Income Generation Policy

1.0 POLICY STATEMENT

- 1.1 As recommended by the Policing Bureaucracy Task Force, income generation can provide a useful tool to assist Forces counter the effects of declining budgets and increasing resource pressures. Police Authorities can enter into agreements with third parties with many benefits, including the ability to generate income and resources that can enhance the policing service that is delivered pursuant to the annual objectives and priorities.
- 1.2 All income generation activities must be carried out in accordance with any relevant legislation, specifically the Police Act 1996, the Data Protection Act 1998, the Freedom of Information Act 2000 and the Prevention of Corruption Act 1916. Such activities must be done in accordance with the set guidelines and template agreements connected to this policy statement. All potential income generation activities must be referred to the Income Generation Manager who has the responsibility to ensure compliance with the relevant legislation.

2.0 OVERVIEW

- 2.1 This policy applies in England, Wales and Scotland.

3.0 APPLICABLE DATE, MONITORING AND REVIEW

- 3.1 This policy is applicable from 16 February 2007.
- 3.2 This policy will be reviewed by March 2010 by the Head of Programme Management Office.
