Two years jail for knife-wielding thug

A man who threatened another man with a knife at Canning Town Tube station has been jailed for 27 months after a witness described him chase his victim down the platform with an eight-inch blade in his hand.

Viet Hoang (20) of West Ham was sentenced at Inner London Crown Court after being found guilty of possessing an offensive weapon at trial.

The court heard how Hoang's victim, a local man also aged 20, was sat on a bench on the Jubilee line platform at about 8.30am on a January morning when he became involved in an altercation with Hoang.

Hoang threatened to kill the man, pulling a large knife from his trousers and trying to corner him on the platform. The victim managed to throw his belongings at Hoang and escape up to the booking hall as Hoang chased him with the knife.

The victim sought refuge with station staff who held the Jubilee line train at the station and called BTP. Officers attended and arrested Hoang.

Hoang was immediately searched, and although the knife was not found, a member of public told the court he saw Hoang chasing the victim down the platform with a large knife, securing a conviction.

Theft conviction

A 44-year-old man has been convicted for a theft offence at London Bridge station thanks to an investigation by Jubilee Line East officers

Paul Dickinson was sentenced to an 18-month conditional discharge and ordered to pay £85 costs plus £150 compensation to the victim.

Investigating officers used CCTV and witness accounts to identify Dickinson, who was working as a licensed busker at the time of the offence. His TFL busking license has also been revoked.
