



**Freedom of Information request 01/FOI/22/1329**

**In each of the last three financial years (18/19) (19/20) and (20/21) please state how much income has been accrued as a result of (a) police issuing fixed penalty notices to motorists and (b) motorists paying for driving training education courses which were offered as an alternative to a Fixed Penalty Notice.**

**NOTE: By accrued I mean how much money will motorists have had to spend to pay fines or to register for courses because of offences committed and administrated by your force.**

**Clarification Received**

**1. In each of the last three financial years (18/19) (19/20) and (20/21) please state that as a result of committing a motoring offence in your authority how much many (a) fixed penalty notices fines were accepted by motorists and (b) how many drivers accepted places on driving training education courses which were offered as an alternative to a Fixed Penalty Notice fine.**

**2. During this three year period what was the financial penalty for (a) a Fixed Penalty Notice and (b) the cost of enrolling on a driver training course.**
