You asked us:

I am looking to update my research regarding what software solutions are currently used to manage and track vetting of police staff and would be most grateful if you would provide me, under the Freedom of Information Act, details in respect to the contract below.

- What, if any, software is used for managing and tracking vetting of police staff?**
- If purchased software is used, what was the start date, duration and value of the contract?**
- Is there an extension clause in the contract and, if so, the duration of the extension?**
- Has a decision been made yet on whether the contract is are being either extended or renewed?**
- Who is the senior person/s (outside of procurement) responsible for managing the force staff vetting process?**
