1. The number of DAPNs issued
2. The number of DAPO hearings that took place
3. The number of DAPOs granted
4. The number of prohibitive or restrictive conditions issued
5. The number of positive requirements issued
6. The number of DAPN/DAPO breaches
7. The number of breaches that resulted in imprisonment
8. The number of positive requirements that received perpetrator consent to engage with
9. The number of positive requirements issued for perpetrator behaviour change programmes
10. The number of positive requirements issued for substance misuse programmes
11. The number of positive requirements issued for mental health support programmes
12. The number of electronic monitoring requirements issued
13. The number of breaches that resulted in a fine
14. The number of breaches that resulted in a fine and imprisonment
