You asked us:

Under the Freedom of Information Act 2000, I would like to request the following information regarding missing persons reports recorded by your police force. Please provide:

- 1. The total number of missing person reports recorded each year from 2020 to 2025 (inclusive).**
- 2. The number of those cases that remain unresolved or open as of today's date.**
- 3. A breakdown by gender, ethnicity and age group (if available) for the unresolved cases.**
- 4. The longest outstanding missing person case currently recorded by your force (please include the year the report was first filed).**
- 5. If held, the total number of cases reclassified as "found deceased" within the same period.**
