



## **Freedom of Information request 1174-13**

**I came across an article on the Internet by your Chief Constable (Andrew Trotter OBE QPM) as the Chair of the ACPO Communications Advisory Group dated: 26 August 2010 entitled: GUIDANCE FOR PHOTOGRAPHERS.**

**Can I simply ask if that guidance to Police Officers is current or if it has been superseded? If it has been superseded, can I please ask you to provide with the URL of the updated guidance so I can download it? Is there anything else related that you can help me with?**

### **RESPONSE**

The document issued by Chief Constable Andrew Trotter is the current guidance.

However, there are limited circumstances where a Police Officer could seize a camera and view images. This can be used where an officer suspects that the photos may be used for the purpose of terrorist activity.
